Good afternoon,

I am emailing today to discuss the possibility of including VMADCP data collected as part of the Atlantic Zone Monitoring Program (AZMP - <https://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/science/data-donnees/azmp-pmza/index-eng.html>) within the Government of Canada, Department of Fisheries and Oceans in the JASADCP archive. The data I am referring to was collected by the Newfoundland and Labrador region from 2007 – present, and consists of roughly three, three week surveys per year (April, July, November) along the St. Pierre bank, Southeast Grand Banks, Flemish Cap, Northeast Newfoundland shelf, and the southern Labrador Sea. This data was collected using an Ocean Surveyor 75 kHz ADCP, and in general was collected on Canadian Coast Guard vessels CCGS Teleost and CCGS Hudson, with some exceptions where the survey was fulfilled by a charter vessel (R/V Coriolis II, RRS James Cook, R/V Atlantis, etc.). All of this data was collected using VMDAS, and processed using CODAS single ping processing (conversion to UHDAS style).

If this data can be included in your archive, could you send me some information regarding how to submit data, what is needed to be included, etc.? Thanks.
