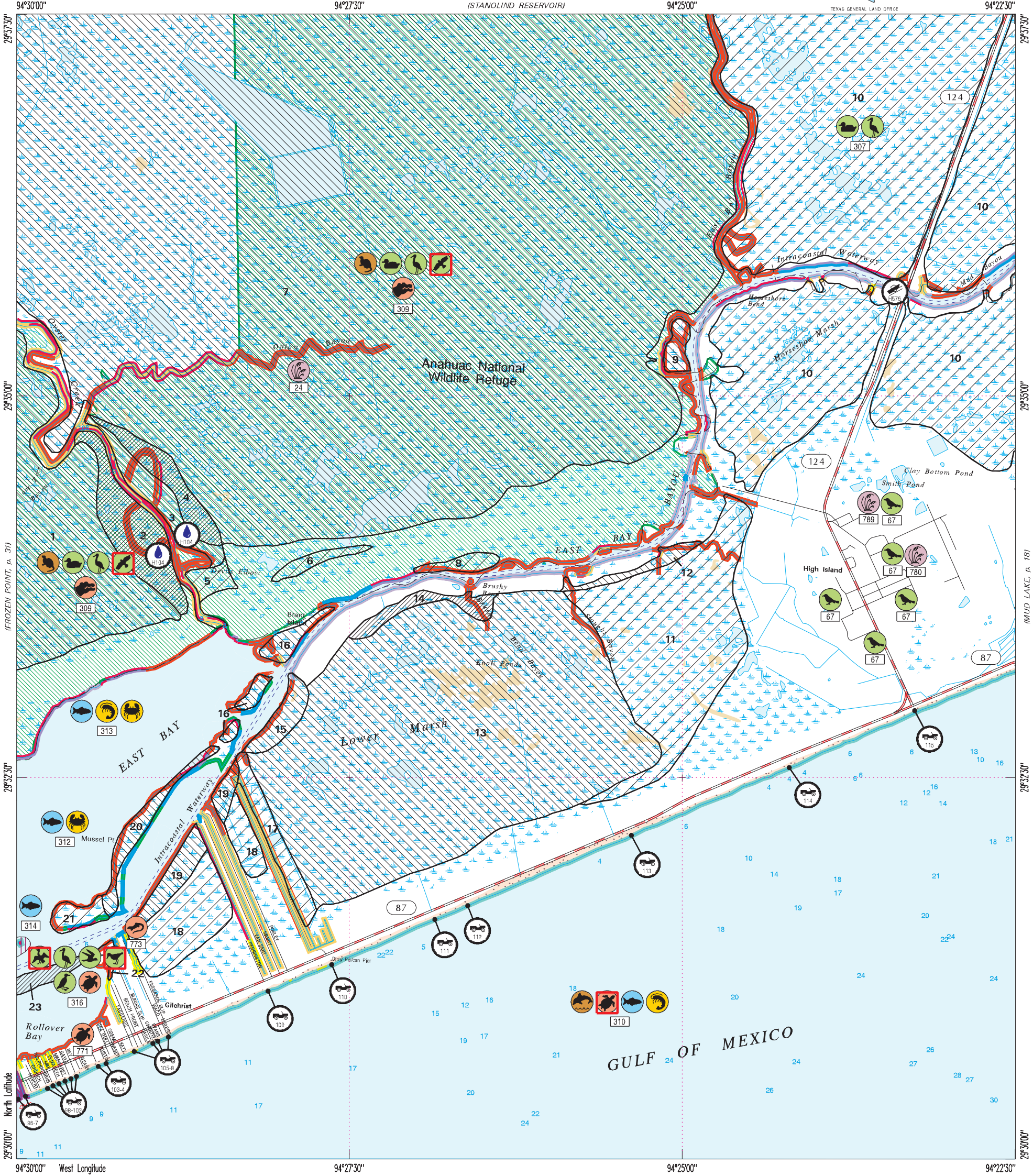


High Island
