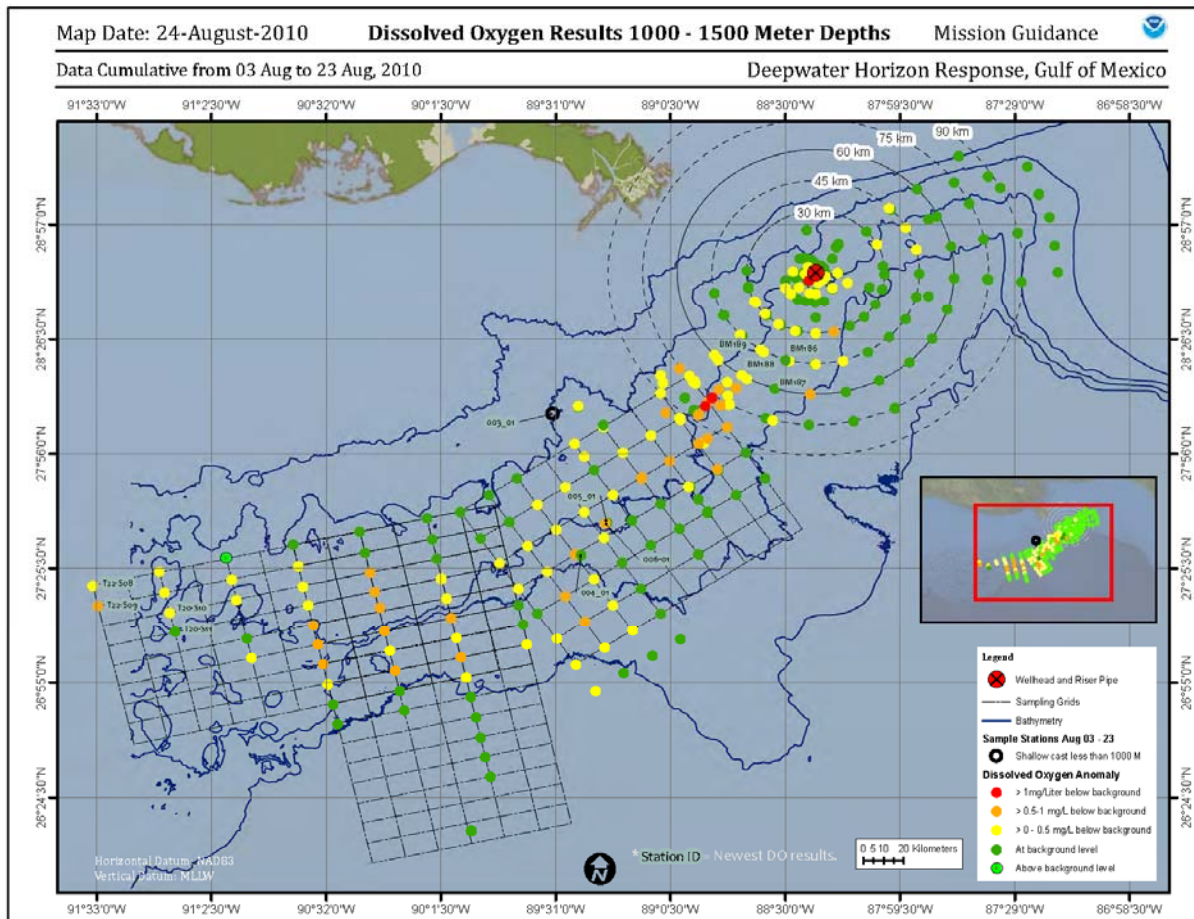


Figure 1 Operation *Clean Sweep* stations as occupied before 8/23/10.

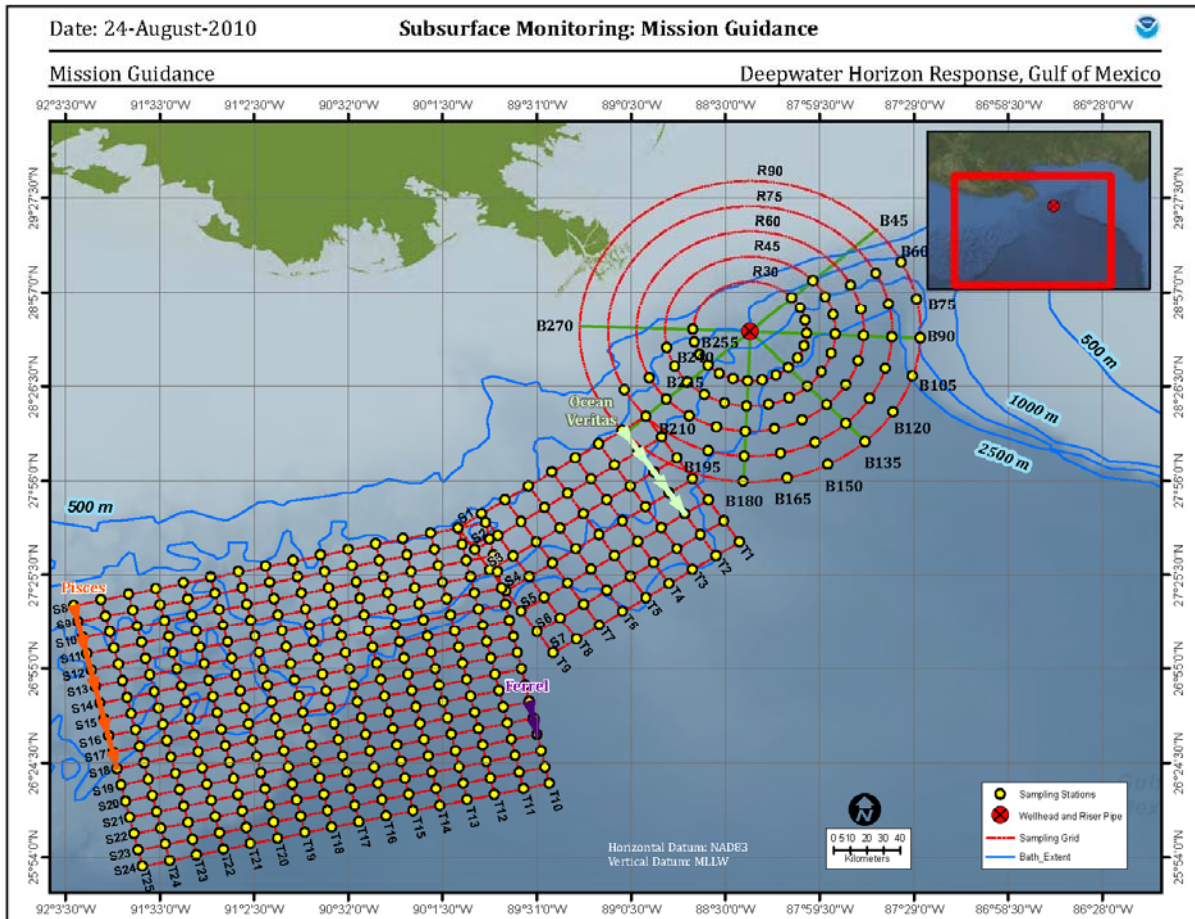


Figure 2 Operational areas for Operation *Clean Sweep* vessels for 8/25/10.
