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Pieces of coral and other marine life that wash upon the shore today break down and help form the white sandy beaches of tomorrow. Please do not remove anything other than trash from the beach.

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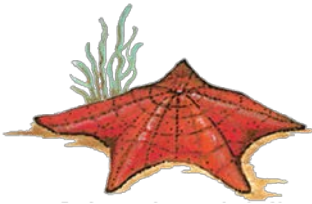


Endangered sea turtles use our beaches by digging nests and laying their eggs under the sand.
