

CoRIS Project Highlights

- Web pages for recent CRCP publications, including (1) Determining Thermal Capacitance for Protected Area Network Design in Palau (http://coris.noaa.gov/activities/thermal_tech/); (2) Report to Congress on the Implementation of the Deep Sea Coral Research and Technology Program 2008-2009 (http://coris.noaa.gov/activities/reportcongress_dscrtp_2010/); (3) Proceedings of the International Workshop on Red Coral Science, Management, and Trade: Lessons from the Mediterranean (http://coris.noaa.gov/activities/lessons_mediterranean/); and (4) Demographic monitoring protocols for threatened Caribbean Acropora spp. corals (http://coris.noaa.gov/activities/dmp_acropora_spp/) were added to the "New Publications" section of CoRIS, which can be accessed from the CoRIS homepage.
- As part of its continuing efforts to better serve users by presenting region-specific coral data and information in a clear, concise, and integrated manner, CoRIS developed a new ecosystem essay about the Republic of Palau. - To improve the functionality of the CoRIS Web site, staff updated the Coral Data search tool to point to html copies of Federal Geographic Data Committee (FGDC) metadata records. The html metadata records are presented so that text will wrap in the browser window, all URLs will be represented as active hyperlinks, and a Table of Contents will be included to allow for easier navigation between different metadata sections.
- CoRIS staff traveled to Miami from March 2-5, 2010 to meet with CRCP partners at the Southeast Fisheries Science Center (SEFSC) and the Atlantic Oceanographic and Meteorological Laboratory (AOML). The site visit included meetings with 23 CRCP Project Managers and staff members, who are a part of AOML, multiple SEFSC facilities in the Southeast (Miami, St. Petersburg, Panama City, FL and Galveston, TX), the Southeast Regional Office (SERO), and the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM). Staff also met with the Deputy Director of SEFSC. CoRIS discussed on-going activities of its project and individual projects in the field; collected outstanding project deliverables; provided basic assistance with FGDC-compliant metadata creation; and obtained substantial insight from the field as to ways in which CoRIS could enhance different website features or tools to better serve CRCP partners and the external user community. CoRIS also conversed with Project Managers and staff about the benefits of archiving data and methods by which to submit data to NOAA National Data Archives for

long-term preservation and public access. In addition, CoRIS received substantial feedback from the field about the current CRCP reorganization process. Questions and comments received were forwarded to the CRCP SEA Team for further review and discussion.

 Notes from the CoRIS orientation presentation and individual project meetings that were part of the site visit to Miami will be compiled shortly into a report with appropriate Actions Items for staff to complete. The site visit report will be distributed to NOAA staff who participated in the workshop, as well as Line Office Representatives at CRCP Headquarters, as appropriate.



Web Use Trends

CoRIS Product Highlights

Metadata – The 3,807 metadata records in CoRIS provide managers, researchers, and the public access to 32,193 coral data products via the CoRIS Web site portal. As identified in Table 4, CoRIS continues to acquire metadata. Between January and March 2010, staff added 223 new metadata records and updated 3,673 records.

Publications – CoRIS received and cataloged 96 coral publications in the CoRIS virtual library or NOAA Library from January–March. Types of products received include NOAA technical memoranda and formal reports, workshop reports, conference proceedings and abstracts, unpublished scientific reports, citations of published journal articles, websites, educational brochures, field guides, and video imagery. The CoRIS Web site currently provides access to 2,464 coral publications and online resources, which are referenced in the NOAA Library or CoRIS virtual library database.

CoRIS serves as a portal to NOAA coral data and information. The project is gathering data and publications from CRCP-funded PIs and other NOAA coral sources and making this information discoverable on the CoRIS Web site for use by the public. The following 10 tables summarize and provide details about the metadata, data, and publications available through CoRIS.
