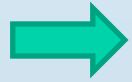
Logistics: Security

 - Alternatively: Use NOAA memory stick (see Candace)

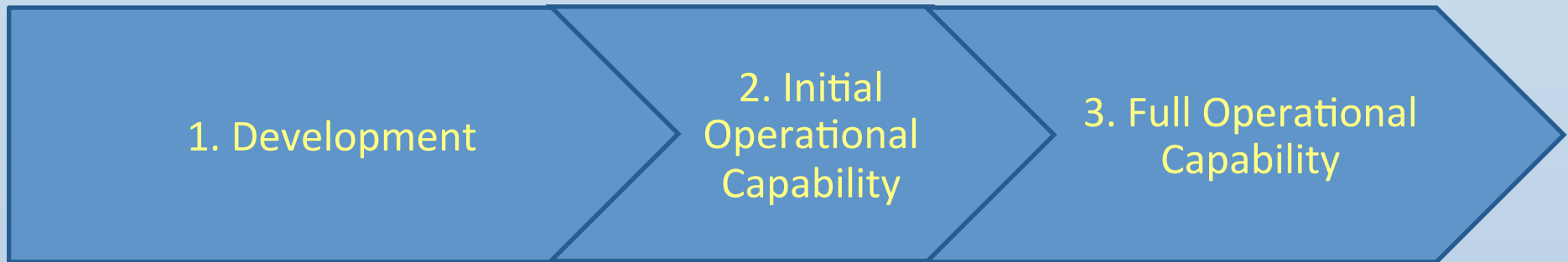

 - Cash bar separate

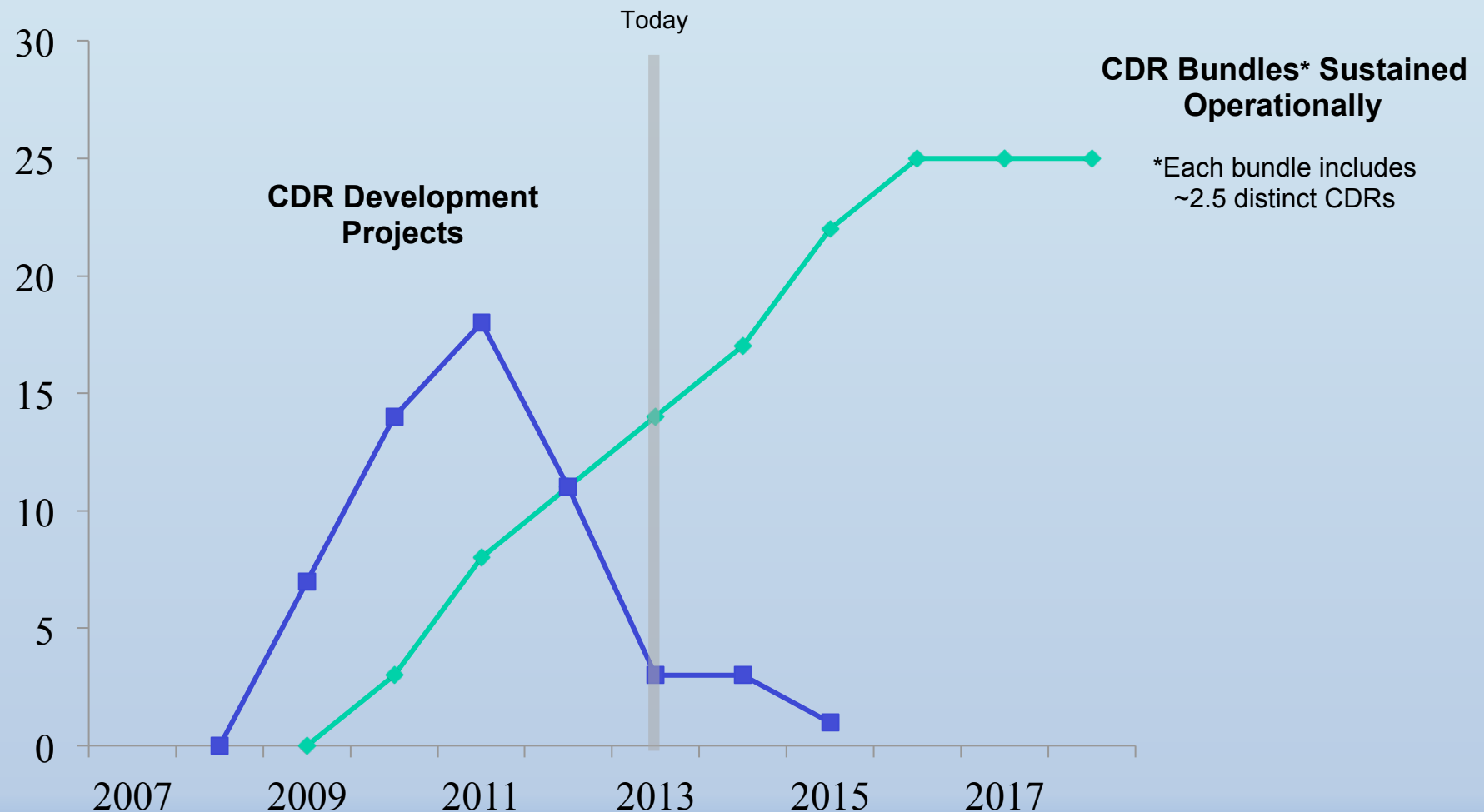

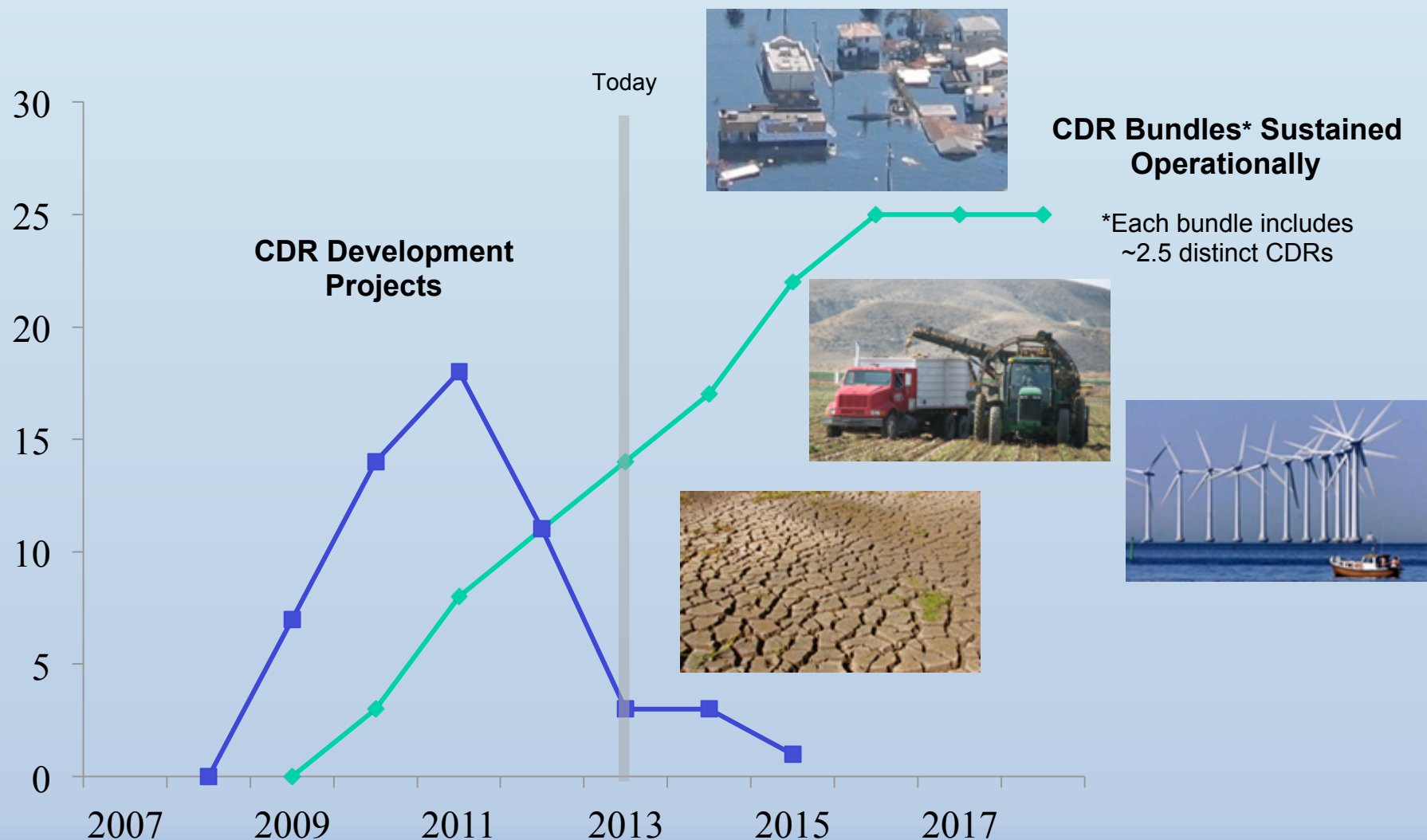

Sustainment in Operations



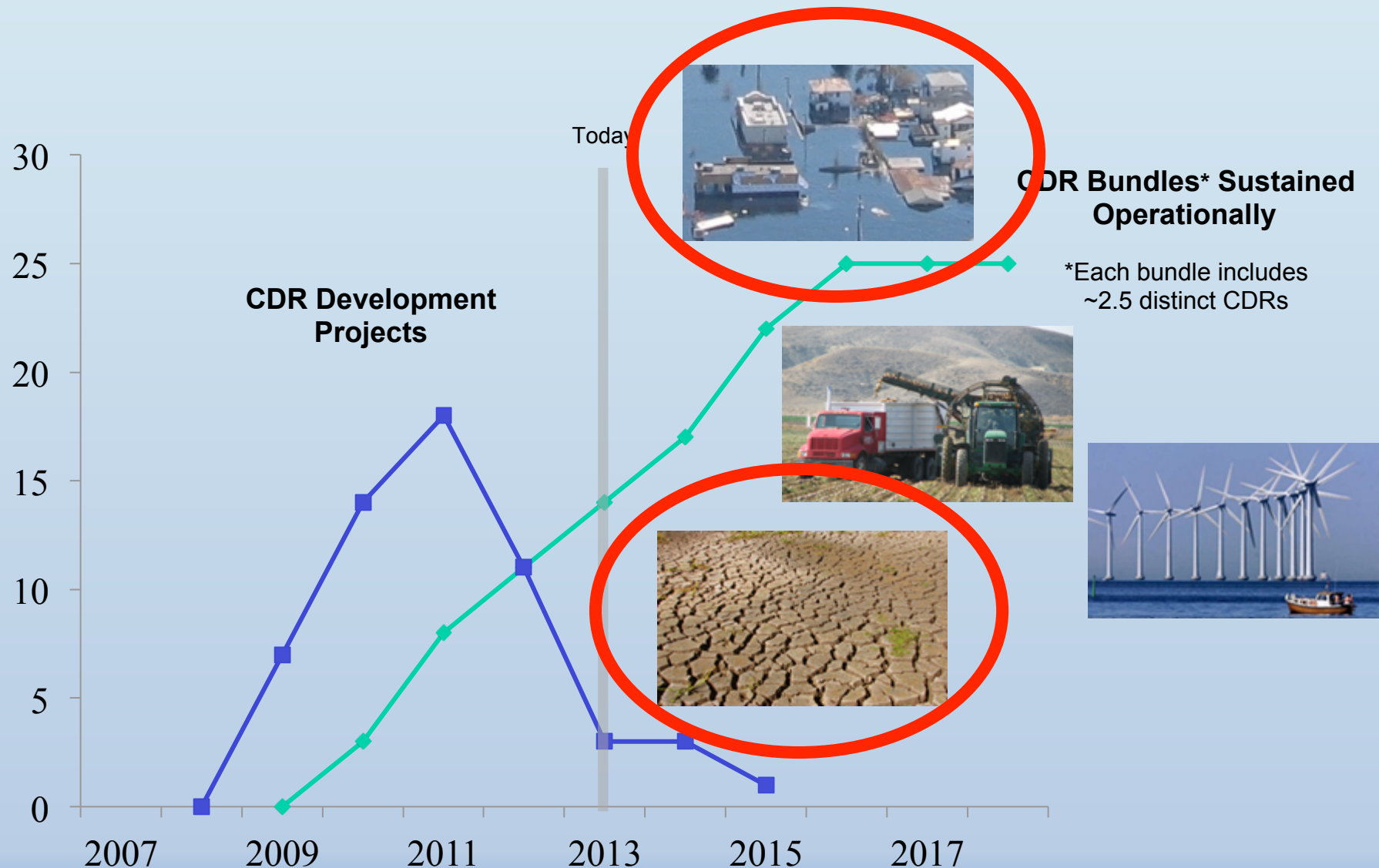
